

Group Captain David Clyde CSM is the Director of the Warfighting Networks and Applications in Defence's Joint Capabilities Group.

Group Captain Clyde graduated as an Air Force Electronics Engineer from the Australian Defence Force Academy in December 1999. He has served in aerospace surveillance, network operations, intelligence, and cyberspace warfare roles, including service on operations in Timor Leste, Iraq, and Afghanistan.
